Medical Tactile, Inc. Signs Multi-Million Dollar Partnership Agreement with Sino Tau International Company, Ltd.

Alliance Will Launch Asian Sales of SureTouch™ Breast Cancer Screening System

Los Angeles – March 14, 2006 – Medical Tactile, Inc. (MTI) – a medical device company specializing in tactile sensing technology -- today announced the signing of a long-term partnership agreement with Sino Tau International Co, Ltd. (Beijing) – one of China’s leading medical device distributors.

Under the terms of agreement, Sino Tau will market, sell and service Medical Tactile’s SureTouch Visual Mapping System in China and other Asian countries (excluding Japan). The agreement involves a minimum of 650 SureTouch units over the next three years, with deliveries beginning during the second quarter of 2006. In addition to serving as Medical Tactile’s primary Asian distributor, Sino Tau will work with the company to initiate a multi-center breast cancer screening clinical trial in China later this year.

“We are pleased to join forces with Sino Tau to launch MTI’s SureTouch system in Asia,” said Steve Weiss, CEO of Medical Tactile, Inc “Sino Tau understands the region’s large and still-growing market for breast cancer screening, and has the specific clinical and medical device experience necessary to ensure a successful product launch.”

Breast cancer is the leading cause of death for women in China, accounting for about 300,000 deaths each year. The incidence has increased in recent years, from 17 per 100,000 in 1999 to 52 per 100,000 in 2003.

Sino Tau’s Managing Director Bai Ge added, “This alliance represents a significant milestone for Sino Tau in the breast cancer field. The SureTouch system is ideally suited to meeting the demands of the fast growing Asian market.”

Introduced in December 2005, the SureTouch system electronically documents the results of clinical breast exams, which are the most accessible first-line of defense against breast cancer for most women. The system is based on Medical Tactile’s proprietary tactile sensing technology, and is designed to improve the sensitivity, specificity and objectivity of such exams.
